


## **CONGESTION SURCHARGE FLOATER**

Valid as of 01.01.2022

The zones white (no congestion), light (mild congestion), medium (congestion) and dark (heavy congestion) are assigned per Post Code, based on the congestion map published anually by the FEDRO (Federal Roads Office)<sup>1</sup>.

The zones are valid for the current calendar year, the congestion level and the congestion zone matrix is adjusted based on the monthly measured congestion volume.

## Calculation of congestion surcharge


The calculation of the congestion surcharge is based on the monthly congestion hours on the Swiss national roads, published by Viasuisse AG<sup>2</sup>. The monthly congestion hours are currently provisional, the remaining months will be updated monthly and might have an impact on the congestion level. The congestion level results from the sum of the congestion hours of the last 12 months.

The congestion surcharge is applied to the net freight price according to the congestion zone matrix.
